The Senior Metrologist will act as lead technician for equipment and related projects, with ability to carry out all aspects from equipment setup through reporting, as well as research into suggested equipment purchases. Utilize a strong base in problem solving skills and scientific principles/theory to assess data integrity and troubleshooting.

Key Job Responsibilities:

Typical responsibilities of the Senior Metrologist may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Plan and carry out/coordinate out all phases of equipment life cycle including, R&D, purchase, calibration & support planning, equipment qualification, data calculation, interpretation & review, troubleshooting, report preparation, and equipment retirement.
- Assess adequacy, completeness, and integrity of historical and/or current calibration/maintenance events vs. current SOPs/standards, identify deficiencies and recommend course of action as necessary.
- Act as lead technician, provide work instructions and technical training to more junior Metrology staff in the conduct of assigned tasks.
- Responds to environmental monitoring system alarms after hours and on weekends.
- Maintain equipment logs and required documentation.
- Interact with clients and/or auditors as necessary.
- Act as technical expert for all aspects of equipment life cycle and problem solving.
