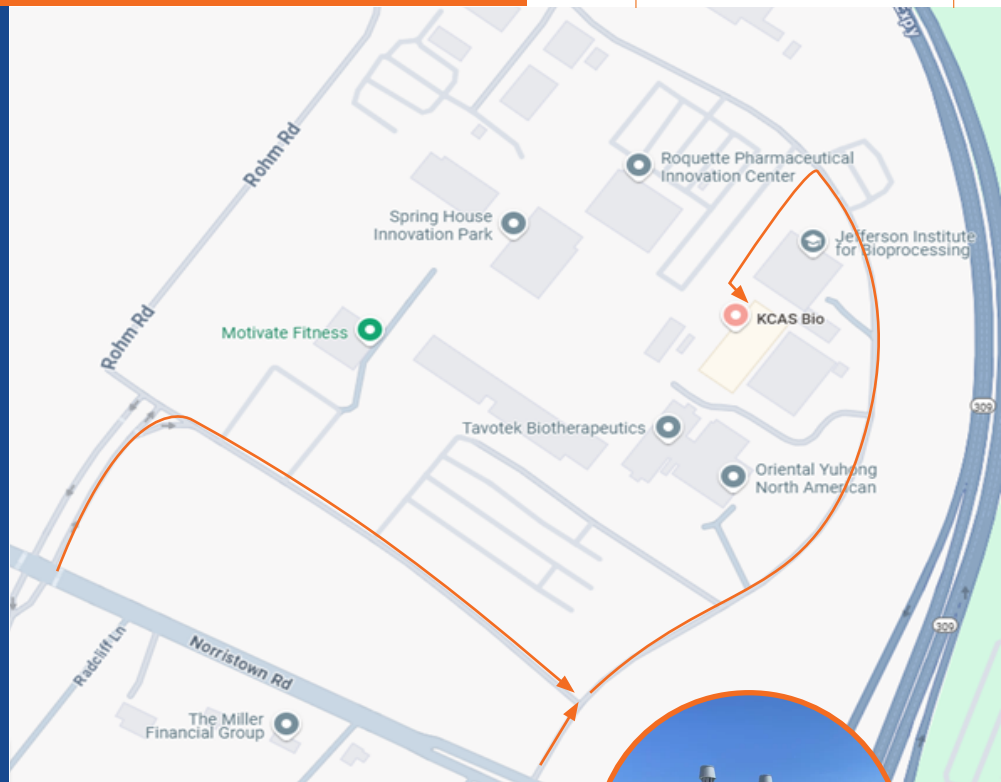

1. Take I-95S to I-476 N (~6 mi total)
2. Take I-476 N to I-276 E (~20 mi)
3. Take I-276 E to PA-309 (~5 mi)
4. Take PA309 to Spring House Exit (~4 mi)
